### **Spotlight: Data Curation**

Data curation ensures that datasets are complete, well-described, and in a format and structure that best facilitates long-term access, discovery, and reuse before publishing or sharing your data. At Cornell, curators will work with you to make your data more

Findable, Accessible, Interoperable and Reusable by aligning with the <u>FAIR Principles</u>. Cornell University Library is also a member institution of the <u>Data Curation Network</u> (DCN), which expands our capacity to curate data from a large number of disciplines and data types by accessing a network of curators across multiple institutions.

### Our curation workflow follows the DCN's established CURATED Steps:

<u>Check files/code and read documentation (risk mitigation, file inventory, appraisal/selection)</u> <u>U</u>nderstand the data (or try to), if not... (run files/code, QA/QC issues, review <u>readme</u> or other <u>metadata</u>)

<u>Request missing information or changes (tracking provenance of any changes and why)</u> <u>Augment metadata for findability (DOIs, metadata standards, discoverability)</u>

<u>Transform file formats for reuse (recommend file formats for longer term reuse and preservation</u>)

<u>E</u>valuate for <u>FAIRness</u> (usage licenses, links to related research, accessibility) <u>D</u>ocument all curation activities throughout the process

# DataWorks! Prize for innovative approaches and tools for data sharing and reuse in biomedical research

Offering a \$500,000 prize purse over 12 awards, and two \$100,000 grand prize awards, the DataWorks! Prize highlights the role of data sharing and reuse in scientific discovery while recognizing and rewarding researchers who engage in these practices. This prize is a partnership between the NIH Office of Data Science Strategy and the Federation of American Societies for Experimental Biology (FASEB). #### New Report on desirable characteristics of research data repositories

## Changes to Google Drive storage | Cornell launch of <u>Strategic Storage Initiative</u> <u>website</u>

Faculty, students, and staff using Google Drive will soon have a storage cap of 15 GB, to be applied at the end of June. The Strategic Storage Initiative also announced other changes to Google services on a <u>new website</u> summarizing **plans for Cornell storage services**, including **Google Drive, Box, and Office 365 storage**.
